The City Council of the City of Rainbow City, Alabama, met in Special Session at City Hall at 9:00 a.m., and upon roll call by City Clerk, Beth Lee, the following members answered present: Mayor Terry John Calhoun, Rodney Prickett, and Rick Hill.
