CITY OF RAINBOW CITY-SPECIAL COUNCIL MEETING-SEPTEMBER 1, 2020

The City Council of the City of Rainbow City, Alabama, met in special session at City Hall at 12:00 Noon. The following members were present: Mayor Terry John Calhoun, Anita Bedwell, Bobby McCartney, Rodney Prickett, Larry Keenum, and Rick Hill. A public notice for the special called meeting was posted on August 26, 2020. Invocation was given by Rodney Prickett. Mayor Calhoun led the Pledge of Allegiance to the flag. The same constituting a quorum of the City Council, the following business was transacted. The meeting was called to order by Mayor Calhoun.

1. Mayor Calhoun stated this meeting was called to canvass the results of the August 25, 2020 municipal general election and turned the meeting over to the City Clerk. The City Clerk welcomed everyone to the canvassing of the election and reported that 34 provisional ballots were cast at the Community Center and 23 were to be canvassed leaving 11 voters who were not eligible to vote. A total of 15 provisional ballots were cast at Fire Station II and 2 of those votes were to be canvassed leaving 13 voters that were not eligible to vote. One provisional absentee vote was received at City Hall and will be canvassed. Each provisional PB3 form was read publicly and the reason why or why not they were to be counted. Provisional canvass tally sheets were made available for the public with sub-totals for each candidate from machines and absentee votes. The results were as follows:
