



CHECKLIST FOR

SWIMMING POOL PERMIT

Commercial: Installation of a pool must meet 2015 IBC Codes

- Copy of Alabama General Contractors Card for swimming pool installation.
- Swimming Pool Permit Application
- Subcontractors List
- Site plan with the following:
 - Proposed pool location
 - Location of pool equipment
 - Distance from pool to the property line
 - Fence around pool
 - Landscape
- Direct access to the pool needs a self-closing gate in lieu of door alarms
- Plans for pools at public assembly locations are to be submitted and approved by the Etowah Health Department

Residential: Installation of a pool must meet 2015 IRC Code

- Copy of Alabama General Contractors Card for swimming pool installation.
- Swimming Pool Permit Application
- Subcontractors List
- Plot plan with the following:
 - Proposed pool location
 - Location of pool equipment & showing distance from equipment to the nearest property line
 - Distance from pool to property line
 - Fence around pool
 - Landscape
 - Retaining wall
- Verification of door alarm for windows & doors with direct access to the pool required. Stairs may have a self-closing gate in lieu of door alarms.

Alabama State General Contractors Law

As owner/builder, you are able to pull the permit yourself. We will need a subcontractors list and a detailed contract from all subcontractors stating their job cost. Job cost is labor, materials, tools, construction equipment cost and installed equipment.

Per the Alabama General Contractors Board, 230-X-1-.26 Fifty-One Percent Regulation,
1. Any project in the State of Alabama for construction, erection, modification, alteration or addition of or to any building, highway, sewer, grading or any improvement or structure where the cost of the undertaking is \$50,000 or more (\$5,000.00 or more in the case of swimming pools) must be constructed by a contractor licensed by the Board. A general contractor may undertake to construct or superintend the construction of any project if 51% or more of the work as measured by the cost (labor, materials, tools, construction equipment cost and installed equipment) falls within the major classification, subclassification or specific subclassification in which the contractor is licensed. On any project where no major classification, subclassification or specific subclassification constitutes 51% or more of the work as measured by the cost (labor, materials, tools, construction equipment cost and installed equipment), the contractor may undertake to construct or superintend the construction of such project if the contractor is licensed in the major classification, subclassification or specific subclassification which constitutes the greatest part of the work on the project as measured by the cost (labor, materials, tools, construction equipment cost and installed equipment).

In short, any of the subcontractors that have a job cost \$5,000 or more will be required to have an Alabama General Contractors license for swimming pools.

ACCIDENT PREVENTION

International Swimming Pool and Spa Code

Swimming pools can be wonderful items that we enjoy during those warmer months, however, they also pose a safety hazard to those around us. According to the ICC, "ISPSA approved pools and spas are designed to reduce child drowning or near drowning incidents by introducing or enhancing existing barrier requirements, compliant designs of exit and entry....". Some of the fundamental "layers" to accident prevention are:

Barrier Requirements (fencing): To isolate the swimming pool by way of a minimum four foot high enclosure.

Automatic Power Safety Cover: A pool cover that is placed over the water area, and is opened and closed with a motorized mechanism activated by a control switch.

Manual Safety Covers: An impenetrable covering that completely covers the pool, spa, or hot tub, blocking access to water.

Door Exit Alarms: An alarm that produces an audible warning when a child opens a door, screen or window.

Self-Closing/Self Latching Devices for Doors and Latching Devices for windows: An approved means of protection, such as, self-closing doors with self-latching devices.

Fence Gate Closer & Latch: To close and latch fence gates securely, making a pool, spa, or hot tub inaccessible to a child.
