CITY OF RAINBOW CITY-COUNCIL MEETING-JULY 12, 2021

The City Council of the City of Rainbow City, Alabama, met in regular session at City Hall at 5:00 p.m. Invocation was given by Anita Bedwell. Mayor Taylor led the Pledge of Allegiance to the flag. The meeting was called to order by Mayor Taylor and upon roll call by City Clerk, Beth Lee, the following members answered present: Anita Bedwell, Randy Vice, Jeff Prince, Jameson Jenkins, Clark Hopper and Mayor Taylor. The same constituting a quorum of the City Council, the following business was transacted.

1. Mayor Taylor presented the minutes of regular Council meeting of June 28, 2021 and special called Council meeting of July 8, 2021 asked if there were any corrections, additions, or deletions. There being none, Jeff Prince made a motion to approve the minutes as presented. Jameson Jenkins seconded the motion. Mayor Taylor stated all in favor say aye. All ayes. Mayor Taylor declared the motion carried.
2. Mayor Taylor stated that the Republic Services rate increase was tabled at the June 28, 2021 Council meeting and asked for a motion and second to remove it from the table. Anita Bedwell made the motion and Jeff Prince seconded the motion to remove it from the table. Jameson Jenkins made a motion to accept the rate increase effective 9/1/21 of \$10.56 per household to be paid by the city as noted in the contract. Anita Bedwell seconded the motion. Mayor Taylor stated all in favor say aye. All ayes. Mayor Taylor declared the motion carried.
3. Mayor Taylor stated that no bids were received for the 2019 Ford F150 VIN# 3843 and no action would be taken at this time.
4. Mayor Taylor stated that bids were opened in Pre-Council at 4:30 p.m. and two (2) bids were received for the 15-ton A/C unit for the Community Center as follows:

Randy Vice made a motion to accept the bid from Childress Heating & Cooling, LLC for \$23,000.00 as they bid for one (1) 15-ton split heat pump with 30KW strip heat. Jeff Prince seconded the motion. Jeff Prince seconded the motion. Mayor Taylor stated all in favor say aye. All ayes. Mayor Taylor declared the motion carried.

5. Kenneth Payne, Chairman of the Beautification Board, presented the 2021 Rainbow City Beautification Awards to the following recipients:

7. Mayor Taylor had a recommendation to hire Kacey Treadaway as part-time in the Library to start Friday, July 16, 2021. Anita Bedwell made a motion hire Kacey. Jeff Prince seconded the motion. Mayor Taylor stated all in favor say aye. All ayes. Mayor Taylor declared the motion carried.
8. Mayor Taylor presented a recommendation to hire Jagger Nance (starts July 16, 2021) and Chris Sholar (starts July 30, 2021) as Certified Police Officers with single coverage insurance. Jameson Jenkins made a motion to hire Jagger Nance and Chris Sholar. Anita Bedwell seconded the motion. Mayor Taylor stated all in favor say aye. All ayes. Mayor Taylor declared the motion carried.
9. Mayor Taylor presented a request to hire Abigail White as a non-certified Dispatcher to start Friday, July 30, 2021 with family coverage insurance. Randy Vice made a motion to hire Abigail White. Jameson Jenkins seconded the motion. Mayor Taylor stated all in favor say aye. All ayes. Mayor Taylor declared the motion carried.
10. Mayor Taylor presented the surplus list for the Library. Jeff Prince made a motion to surplus these items and accept sealed bids to be opened on Monday, July 26, 2021 at 4:30 p.m. Anita Bedwell seconded the motion. Mayor Taylor stated all in favor say aye. All ayes. Mayor Taylor declared the motion carried.
11. Mayor Taylor presented the monthly departmental reports from: Animal Control, Building, Community Center, Court, Fire, Library, and Police.
